

#### **Red Bean Pancakes**

On Wednesday we made Japanese red bean pancakes.

This is because we are reading the book Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes by Eleanor Coerr which is about a Japanese girl who gets leukaemia from the atomic bomb dropped on Hiroshima in 1945. We made them because they were her favourite cakes and we wanted to taste them.

We used Adzuki beans which are small red beans that are most often used Japanese cooking for sweet treats.

We mixed eggs, sugar, honey, flour and baking powder for the pancakes with a whisk.

While the pancake mix rested in the fridge, we made the bean paste by cooking the adzuki beans with sugar and salt in the same pot and then we mashed them up into the paste.

The pancakes tasted of honey and they were delicious with the red bean paste.

I'm 17 years old.


When I finish school I want to be a firefighter because I want to save people.

Our students and staff have listened to her story about the Creation of Port Phillip Bay and have learned about the creation ancestors, Bunjil, Waang and Rainbow Serpent. I am very proud to see our students being respectful and asking questions to find out and learn more about Aboriginal history.

Auntie Sammy is taking residence in our new school library every Monday. She is also working with the students and staff to make art and music to transform the space into a community hub.

We are appreciative of Regional Arts Victoria and Baluk Arts for supporting this program. I would also like to extend my thanks to our Koorie Support Engagement Officer, Stephanie Briggs for her support in our application for this program.
